Mon. & Wed. 7:30 am to 5:30 pm

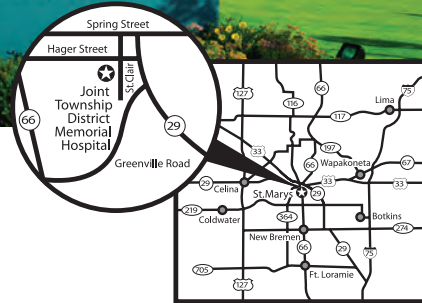
During these hours patient evaluations and treatments are performed. Patients may call or walk in to schedule an appointment during these hours as well.

Full evaluation of a musculoskeletal injury, neurological injury, or speech therapy for language and voice problems can last about 1 hour. Follow-up treatments are scheduled for 30 minutes to 1 hour, depending on each patient's need.
