# Regional Health Care Leader Named Platinum Partner in Hospital Champions for Organ Donation Program

Donate Life Ohio, Ohio Hospital Association and the Ohio Department of Health's Second Chance Trust Fund honor Grand Lake Health System for organ donation advocacy

ST. MARYS, Ohio (June 13, 2013) – Grand Lake Health System, a nonprofit health care provider serving residents of the Grand Lake region, has been named a Platinum Partner in the Small Hospital category of the 2012-2013 Hospital Champions Program sponsored by Donate Life Ohio, the Ohio Hospital Association and the Ohio Department of Health Second Trust Fund. Grand Lake Health System is one of only four hospitals in Ohio to be recognized as a Platinum Partner. The other three hospitals include Genesis HealthCare System-Bethesda, MetroHealth System and The Ohio State University Wexner Medical Center. All hospitals were recognized at the 2013 OHA Annual Meeting held June 11, 2013.

The Hospital Champions for Organ Donation Program worked to increase awareness of the need for organ, eye and tissue donor registration. All hospitals participating in the program were able to earn points for their participation. The number of points earned designates which level of recognition the hospitals received. Platinum recognition is the highest level of recognition. Points were earned based on the number of community outreach programs facilitated and people reached by the participating hospital. Through its community outreach efforts including talks and presentations at various organizations, civic groups and local companies, Grand Lake Health System was able to reach more than 1,000 members of the Grand Lake region. GLHS also appeared on local media generating an additional 6,000 media impressions.

"We are so pleased to be named with this honor," says Sonnnie Bernardi, Performance Improvement Manager for Grand Lake Health System and Committee Chair for the Program. "For months, we consistently facilitated quality community outreach programs that not only educated our community but provided an opportunity for open dialogue around this important topic affecting thousands of Ohioans."

According to the Ohio Department of Health, more than 114,000 people nationwide and more than 3,400 people in Ohio await a lifesaving organ transplant. In addition, more than 170 Ohioans died in 2012 when a lifesaving organ could not be found in time for transplant. However, by participating in this important program, Grand Lake Health System took the necessary steps to reduce this number.
