Celina Medical Center Fact Sheet

- The \$2.5 million dollar construction project will add a 15,000 sq. ft. one story addition onto the existing 10,000 sq. ft. Celina Medical Center on Pro Drive in Celina next to the Grand Lake Regional Cancer Center.
- The Celina Medical Center is affiliated with the Grand Lake Health System and Joint Township District Memorial Hospital.
- The Celina Medical Center has been operated by the Grand Lake Health System since 1989 and the facility was built in early 1980's.
- The Celina Medical Center houses the region's largest family practice and includes Terry Roode, D.O., family practice; Michael Josey, M.D., family practice; Peter White, M.D., family practice and Karen Swarts, M.D., pediatrics. Dr. Roode has practiced at the Celina Medical Center since 1989.
- A major portion of the new addition will accommodate the growing needs of the four current physicians at the Celina Medical Center as well as the space needs of future physicians who may be located at the facility.
- Approximately 3,670 sq. ft. of the addition will house an imaging center with comprehensive imaging services which may include mammography, MRI, CT, ultrasound, and other radiological equipment and services.
- The facility will be designed to accommodate after hours care.
- The construction project will anticipate future needs and have the ability to adjust to and accommodate community needs through additional physicians and services.
- The anticipated project completion date is late 2007.
