

Life Saving Screenings Without symptoms, how do you know if you have vascular disease?

Vascular disease is one of the leading causes of disability and death in the United States — however, often there are no symptoms until it is too late.



Vascular screenings can help detect three vascular diseases:

1) Carotid Artery -

This is a painless ultrasound test to visualize the build up of fatty blockage in the carotid artery. This test helps identify the risk of stroke.....\$20

2) Abdominal Aorta -

This is a painless ultrasound test to detect abdominal aneurysms that could rupture and be fatal. The largest majority of people who have an aneurysm have no symptoms......\$20

3) Peripheral Artery Disease -

This is a painless measurement of circulation to your legs to detect peripheral arterial disease. Abnormal results indicate high risk of coronary artery disease and peripheral artery disease\$20

Do I need to make an appointment?

Please wear loose fitting clothes and no pantyhose, so that the technologist has easy access to your neck, stomach, and lower legs.

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
